Cost per watt

Cost per watt (£/W) is the overall cost divided by the system size e.g. a project cost of £8,000 for a 4 kW system would be:

$$\text{£8,000} / 4000 \text{ watts} = \text{£2/W}$$

The national average cost per watt is £1.50/W
